



## Ministry Offers Free or Low-Cost Medications to Patients

Greater Hickory Cooperative Christian Ministry (GHCCM) Pharmacy offers qualified patients access to low and no-cost medications through partnerships with national organizations, patient assistance programs, medication donations, and pharmacy wholesaler purchases.

- GHCCM pharmacy can fill prescriptions for eligible patients who are seen by any licensed healthcare provider.
- Our pharmacy carries most of the **top 200 most commonly prescribed medications**, including long and short-acting insulins (Our pharmacy does NOT fill any controlled substances)..

- GHCCM Pharmacy has several medications available from **FREE** programs and these medications have **NO PATIENT FEES**.
- Other medications on hand carry a fee of \$4.00 (or higher) for each 30 day fill.

### ELIGIBILITY

***PATIENTS WHO PREVIOUSLY DID NOT QUALIFY MAY NOW BE ELIGIBLE for pharmacy services, as GHCCM now accepts patients who fall within 300% of Federal Poverty Guidelines:***

Persons in household	300% Poverty Income level
1	\$45,180
2	\$61,320

*To qualify for a GHCCM Healthcare card:*

- Patient must be at least 18 years old and a resident of Catawba or Alexander Counties.
- Patients must have NO insurance and NO prescription coverage (Patients with Medicaid, Medicare, VA coverage, or other healthcare coverage are not eligible for pharmacy services).
