MEDICAL MINISTRY CLINIC ELIGIBILITY

GHCCM's medical programs are available to individuals 18 and over, residing in Catawba or Alexander Counties.

Individuals looking to qualify for medical, vision, and dental services must meet the 300% Federal Poverty Guidelines and be ineligible for Medicaid, Medicare, and private insurance.

Individuals who are underinsured or have Medicare and meet the 300% Federal Poverty Guidelines may qualify for dental and vision services.
